Drug Impaired Driving/DRE Toxicology testing is available in blood, urine and oral fluid, and includes:

- **Cannabis** (marijuana)
- **Central Nervous System (CNS) Stimulants** (cocaine, "crack," amphetamines, methamphetamine/"crank," Ritalin®)
- **CNS Depressants** (barbiturates, anti-anxiety tranquilizers, benzodiazepines, sleep aids, Ambien®, SOMA®)
- **Hallucinogens** (LSD, mescaline, MDMA and more)
- **Dissociative Drugs** (PCP, ketamine, dextromethorphan)
- **Narcotic Analgesics** (opioids, codeine, heroin, Demerol®, Darvon®, morphine, methadone, Vicodin®, Oxycontin®)
- **Inhalants** (1,1-DFE, freon, toluene, xylene and more)
