At steady-state, approximately 23% of an oral
dose is excreted into the urine as unchanged drug.

This test is not Chiral specific. Patients who have
taken Escitalopram (Lexapro®), as opposed to Racemic
Citalopram (Celexa®), within the past 3 days may have
falsely elevated values.
